EXAM FORMAT

- Oral exam with written exercises
- Teleworking on Microsoft Teams

ESSE3 PROCEDURE

- 1) The teacher creates an exam on ESSE3.
- 2) Students book on ESSE3.
- 3) Results are registered without publication *senza pubblicazione degli esiti* because immediately communicated to every student at the end of their exam.

MICROSOFT TEAM PROCEDURE

- 1) The teacher creates the channel **Exam of DD/MM/YYYY** in the team of the course.
- 2) The teacher schedules on this channel one or more meetings named **Group N**, where N is a number.
- 3) The teacher reports in the chat the group assigned to every student.
- 4) Students join their meeting place a webcam in front of them. Desks must be clearly visible at any time from webcams. Students can use blank papers, pens and pencils. No other items are permitted. Microphones must be on at any time.
- 5) Students are identified by their university ID *tesserino universitario* shown via webcam upon request by the teacher.

EXAMINATION PROCEDURE

- 1) The teacher assigns one or more exercises, open answer and closed answer, to be done on paper or on computer. The teacher also specifies the allotted time.
- 2) Students report completion of exercises to the teacher. Paper exercises are digitally scanned for example, using the webcam.
- 3) The teacher discusses with every student, in a private channel. Possibly, the teacher assigns new exercises or provides new instructions for the already assigned exercises. The teacher may also ask to answer questions about all arguments of the course.
- 4) After the discussion, the teacher communicate the result to the student, and conclude the examination.

NOTES

1) Recording of the exam is not permitted in any form to anyone, with the exception of the examiners, who are permitted to record with the only purpose to verify suspicious activities. Anyhow, such a recording is destroid after the exam is concluded.
